



## **TRAVELLING FROM THE FERRY TERMINALS**

If you are travelling by ferry from France, Belgium, the Netherlands and Spain the drive from the nearby ferry ports is relatively easy. Detailed below are examples of routes from some of the major ferry ports in the South of England. - From Dover: Follow signs for the A20 (signposted London, Channel Tunnel, M20) and continue on to the M20 towards London. Leave the M20 at junction 3 and join the M26 (signposted Gatwick, Heathrow, M25). Continue onto the M25 (signposted Gatwick Airport). Leave the M25 at junction 7 and join the M23 southbound, following directions for Brighton and Gatwick Airport. Continue onto the A23 and this will lead you to the roundabout opposite the Brighton Pier. At the roundabout turn right (towards Hove) and we are about 500 metres along the seafront. The journey time is around 2 hours (depending on traffic).
- From Portsmouth: Follow signs for the M275 (signposted Out of City, M27). Keeping in the right hand lanes continue onto the M27 (signposted Brighton, Chichester). Continue onto the A27 (signposted Havant, Brighton). Continue on the A27 until the Mill Road Roundabout (with the A23) heading towards Brighton City Centre and the seafront. The A23 will lead you to the roundabout opposite the Brighton Pier. At the roundabout turn right (towards Hove) and we are about 500 metres along the seafront. Journey time is around 1 hour and 15 minute (depending on traffic).
- From Plymouth: Follow signs towards Exeter and the A38 (signposted Exeter). Join the M5 (signposted Taunton, Honiton, Barnstaple). Leave the M5 at junction 29 onto the A30 towards Honiton and then merge onto the A35 (signposted Dorchester). Continue on the A35 heading towards Poole and then follow signs for the A31 (signposted Wimborne). Continue on the A31 (signposted Ringwood) and then continue onto the M27 (signposted London, Southampton, Winchester). Continue onto the A27 (signposted Havant, Brighton). Continue on the A27 until the Mill Road Roundabout (with the A23) heading towards Brighton City Centre and the seafront. The A23 will lead you to the roundabout opposite the Brighton Pier. At the roundabout turn right (towards Hove) and we are about 500 metres along the seafront. Journey time is around 4 hours and 30 minutes to 5 hours (depending on traffic).
- From Newhaven: From the Ferry Terminal follow signs for the Town Centre and then follow signs for Peacehaven. This road is the A259 and will take you along the coast into Brighton. At the roundabout opposite the Brighton Pier go across and take the second exit (towards Hove). We are about 500 metres along the seafront. Journey time is around 20 minutes (depending on traffic).
